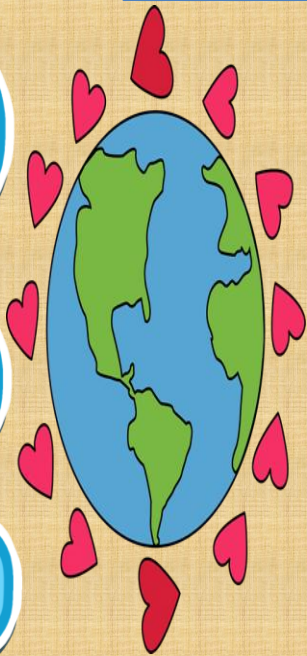

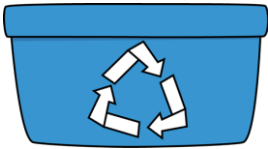

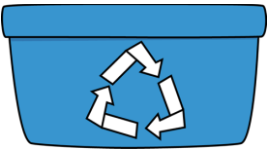
Context Clues:

We should conserve water by taking shorter showers and by turning off the water while brushing our teeth.



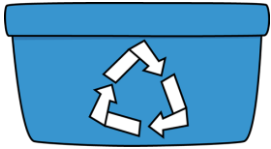
To Save;

Smog or smoke from trucks or cars causes air pollution.



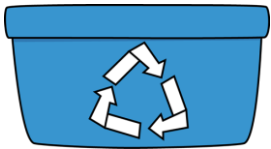
Harmful or poisonous substances in the air



When we throw trash into the lakes and rivers, we contaminate the water needed for the animals.



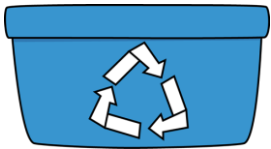
Infect;

We need clean oxygen to have healthy lungs.



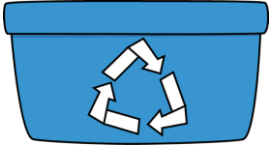
What we breathe in from the earth that gives us energy.



You can recycle by choosing containers for plastic items, cans, paper, clothes, and electronics.



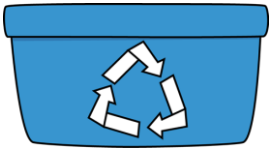
Processing used or abandoned materials for use in creating new products



We need to protect the environment for the next generation.



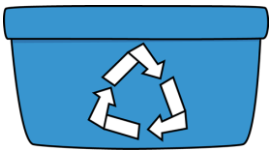
The whole complex of factors (as soil, climate, and living things) the earth community.



Earth is the third planet from the Sun. It has continents and oceans, and is very big.



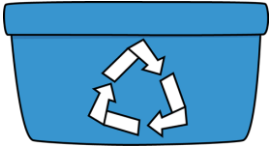

The Environmental Protection Agency is sponsoring a recycling event next month.



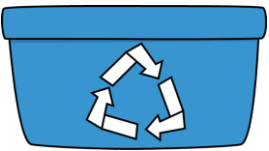
An agency established by the United States government to fight pollution and protect the environment.



My mother reuses Pringles' cans for storage for my markers and crayons.



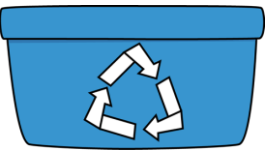
To use again, especially in a different way.

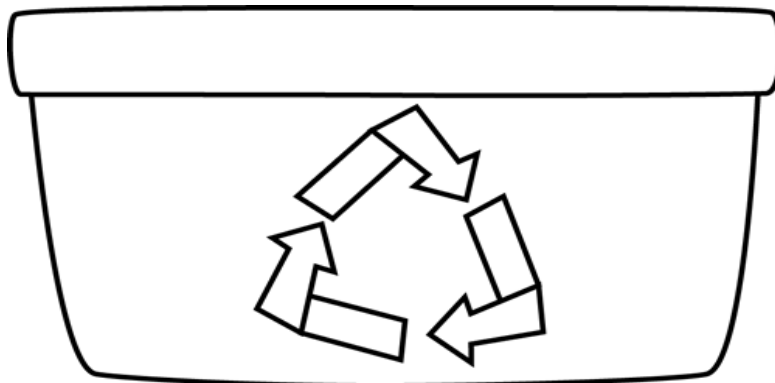
